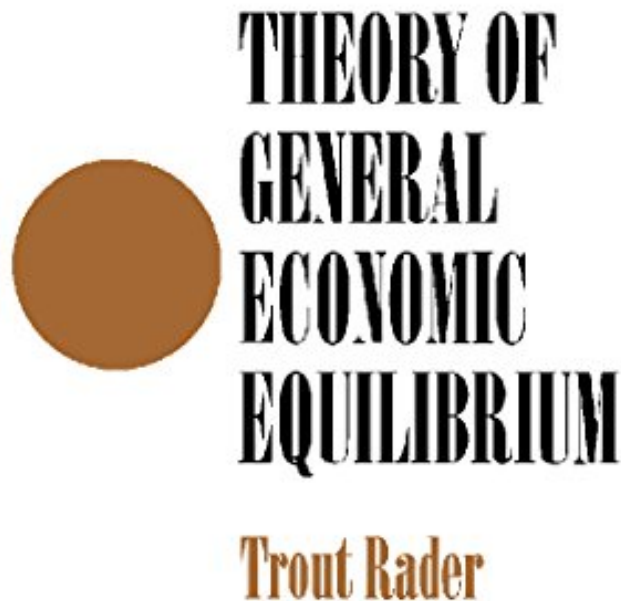

This text then
